Reminder: **Windows 10** versions 2004 and prior will not receive further Windows security updates. The upgrade to the current Windows 10 21H2 version is free and recommended.

We still recommend that business users wait to install **Windows 11**. Another group of fixes to known bugs will be [released this month](#), along with some features not included in the original release. The update includes a preview of the ability to run Android apps.

Reminder: [Microsoft 365 prices will go up in March](#). Purchase any licenses or renewals this month to get the existing (lower) price. It is possible to extend your existing subscription prior to the price increases. Microsoft 365 Business Basic (from \$5 to \$6 per user), Microsoft 365 Business Premium (from \$20 to \$22), Office 365 E1 (from \$8 to \$10), Office 365 E3 (from \$20 to \$23), Office 365 E5 (from \$35 to \$38), Microsoft 365 E3 (from \$32 to \$36)

Microsoft Defender is now included with several Microsoft 365 plans at no extra cost. Configuration is needed to take full advantage of the new features.

[IRS will Soon Require ID.me with selfies for Online Access.](#)

By the summer of 2022, the only way to log in to irs.gov will be through ID.me, an online identity verification service that requires applicants to submit copies of bills and identity documents, as well as a live video feed of their faces via a mobile device. Some 27 states already use ID.me to screen for identity thieves applying for benefits in someone else's name. The authentication process can take a lot of work and time, so you may want to get it set up before you need it.


