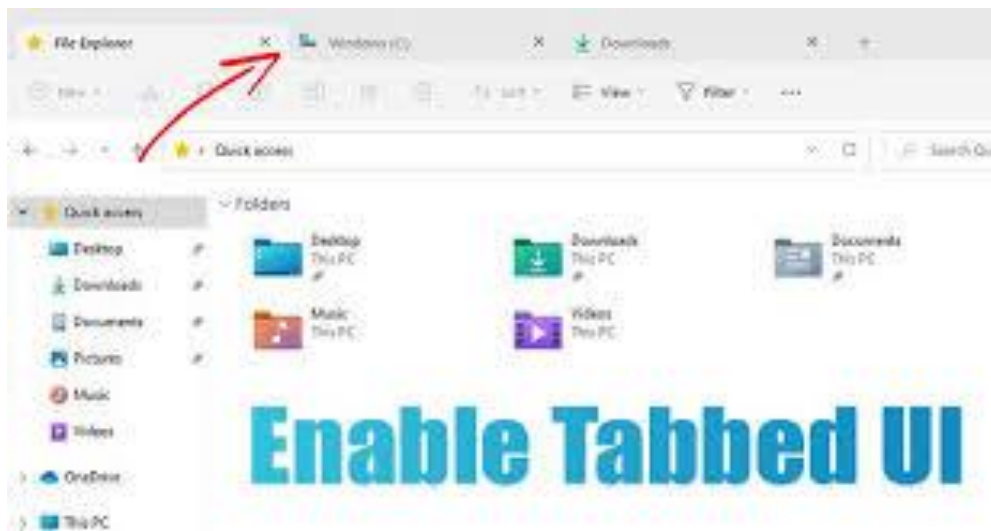

The **Windows 11** 2022 update (22H2) [is now available](#).  
This is the first significant update to Windows 11. [New features](#).  
Windows 11 22H2 [Issues and upgrade stoppers](#).

The tabs in Windows Explorer (shown below) won't come until sometime in October via the "Moment 1" update. "[Moment update](#)" is the new term for [minor updates to Windows 11 features](#).



Microsoft is introducing a new encryption type that works separately from BitLocker and relies on Windows Hello password technology to encrypt files rather than full volumes. Called [Personal Data Encryption](#), it requires an Education or Enterprise license.

**Windows 10 20H2 (November 2020 release)** is no longer supported. Versions 21H1 and 21H2 are the [currently supported versions](#). It is a free upgrade. Support for version 21H1 ends December 13<sup>th</sup>. You can check your version by typing WINVER in the search bar.

[Windows 10 22H2](#) is now expected in October. No significant new features are expected.

Microsoft is [disabling Exchange Online basic authentication](#) for email starting October 1st. As mentioned last month, some older printer/copiers may stop sending scans via email if configured to use older email authentication standards. Some software that sends email may also be affected.

**Google** is currently [disabling service for G Suite Legacy Free accounts](#) until they upgrade to a newer Google Workspace account. You can identify as a personal user and revert to a no-cost subscription.

Businesses using **biometric time clocks** need to be sure that they have a comprehensive compliance program that meets [all of the requirements of applicable law](#) to comply with new privacy laws.

[Kindle Scribe' e-reader](#) allows writing on the tablet.

The [upgraded Kindle](#) has a battery life of up to six weeks, USB-C charging, and 16GB of storage.

The new [Kindle Paperwhite](#) has a bigger screen and longer battery life.

A larger-capacity **SSD** (Solid State hard Drive) wears more slowly than one of lesser capacity, given the same use pattern. The rewrite operations are spread across more blocks, which causes them to wear more slowly. Buy and install the largest SSD that is practical.

Recommended SSD brands include Crucial (aka Micron), Intel (SSD interests sold to SK Hynix), Kioxia (spun off from Toshiba), Samsung, SK Hynix (part of the South Korean chaebol SK Group), and Western Digital and its subsidiary SanDisk. These brands have proven themselves over time.
